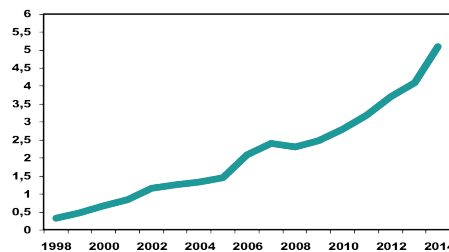

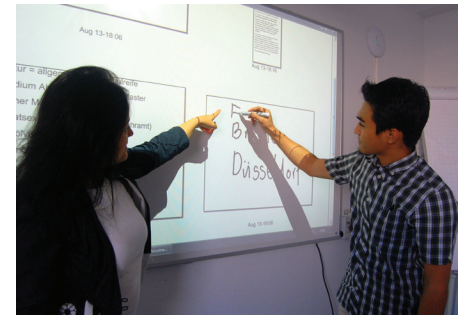
Cooperations and funding
